We would like to invite you to an E-Safety workshop for parents / carers on **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2019** at 6 -7 pm. The workshop is for adults, but any child from Classes 1 to 5 can also attend.

- The aims are to provide parents / carers with an overview of the following:
- E-safety in the Computing Curriculum and the key messages that we give the children in school.
- The potential risks of internet / social media use for children
- The importance of communication with children about the time they spend online
- An understanding of how to find out about setting up parental controls on home and mobile devices
- Know what to do if your child encounters problems online

In addition, there will be an opportunity for you to share any ideas that you use at home in order to promote safe behaviour online.

I must stress that this is not about us sharing scare stories with you - at Oxspring Primary School we firmly believe that the internet and online activity is, and will continue to be, an important part of our children's lives. Our aim is for children to develop the online habits that will keep them safe. This is an excellent opportunity for you to find out what messages we are giving the children in order to strengthen our partnership when working towards this aim. Any children attending will access age appropriate e-safety resources for part of the session.
