### How do the grown-ups help children who find learning difficult?

Makaton signs of the week help communicate with other pupils  
They don't get cross at people when it's difficult  
They try and explain it again so it's easier  
Teachers put things on the wall to help us remember  
They don't just stay with one person they work with others  
Practise things like times tables when lining up  
If maths is tricky they go through it again  
Help you learn new skills so it's easier  
They sit with you if you find it difficult  
They help us to sound out words  
They know what the children can't do  
The staff are good because they listen to what we say and help  
They come to us when we ask for help and if we don't understand, the teacher will explain it to us.  
Explain the process slowly and explain the method.  
People are supportive to others who find learning difficult.  
One to one help to check  
Numicon, number lines, 100 squares, sound cards, alphabet  
Work in groups with other children who find learning difficult  
They calmly explain it to children that need help  
Things I can touch and see  
Going to quieter rooms  
Teaching assistants help  
Get their learners toolkits out.  
They explain it bit by bit and it really helps.  
They recap if you don't get it.
