

Here are some ideas of activities you could try at home linked to the work we are doing this half term. Perhaps choose a different activity to have a go at each week. We would love to know how you get on and would be grateful if you could record what you have done with your child through writing, drawings or photographs in this home-school book.

Encourage your child to make up a story about an alien visiting your house. They could dictate a story for you to write in their book or have a go at writing a few sentences themselves.

Challenge your child to find 3 objects in the house that are longer than their shoe and 3 objects that are shorter. Can they order them from shortest to longest? Can they work out how many pennies or paperclips long their shoe is?

Create a space picture. Your child could use paint, collage materials, crayons or felt tip pens. They could include a space rocket or even aliens.

Find out about the planets in our Solar System. Encourage your child to draw one of them and write an interesting fact about it in their book.

Support your child to write a list of what they would take with them if they were going into space.
