Create your own stone age poem.	Write down some questions that you like to ask a person who lived in the Stone Age.	Make up your own Stone Age game.
Create a multiplication and division game to test your rapid recall.	The wheel was invented in the Stone Age. Create a comic to show Stone Age people inventing it.	What would a Stone Age person have eaten? Create a recipe using food that they would have found.
