<b>Make a clock</b> Design and make a clock using Roman numerals.	<b>Soldier/ emperor</b> Draw a picture of a Roman soldier or emperor.	<b>Roman Places</b> Research names of towns during the Roman invasion of Britain
<b>Maths</b> Create a multiplication and division game to test your rapid recall.	<b>Rome</b> Use holiday brochures or the internet to research Rome. Write about what Rome is like today.	<b>Roman villa</b> Research what a Roman villa looks like. Can you draw one or create a model?
