a local charity.

Below is a list of suggested items that can be put into the shoebox.

Shoeboxes should be wrapped (lid and box separately), include a Christmas card and be clearly labelled with MALE or FEMALE.

<u>Clothes</u> <i>Hat, scarf, gloves</i> <i>Warm socks</i> Underwear Waterproof clothing Emergency foil blanket	<u>Food</u> <i>Sweets or chocolate treats or biscuits</i> <i>Drink sachets of tea or coffee or hot chocolate</i> <i>Food sachets of soup or mugshots or noodles</i> Tinned foods (ring pull cans only) Bottles of pop/water Prepaid gift cards for food or drinks e.g.Greggs
<u>Toiletries</u> <i>Toothbrush and toothpaste</i> <i>Deodarant or body spray</i> <i>Shower gel or shampoo</i> <i>Baby wipes or facial wipes</i> <i>Hair brush or comb</i> <i>Sanitary products</i> Body moisturiser Lip balm Tissues	<u>Other items</u> <i>Ziplock bags</i> <i>Windup torch</i> Notepad and pen with stamped envelope Hand warmers Books, e.g. puzzle book or reading book Insulated mug or flask
<p><b>NO</b> alcohol, money, bars of soap, alcohol based products i.e.hand sanitiser, razors or candles</p> <p>Items in <i>italics</i> are essential items for a homeless man or woman, if possible please try to include an item from each list. As these are Christmas presents, no second hand or used items please.</p>	

Please hand your filled shoebox into school no later than **MONDAY 2 DECEMBER** as they will then be collected and taken to one of the drop-off points for the charity to distribute.
