### Home learning Grid

<b>Questions</b> What questions would you ask someone who lived in the prehistoric age?	<b>Quiz</b> Write a quiz about the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age.	<b>Poem</b> Write a poem about living in the Stone Age.
<b>Model</b> Make a model of a prehistoric house. How did they change over from the Stone Age to the Iron Age?	<b>Literacy</b> Write a set of instructions to wash an animal. It could be a prehistoric animal.	<b>Maths</b> Play with a partner. Get a pack of cards. Turn them over and quickly add them. The first to add them in the winner.
<b>Science</b> With an adult, talk about what fossils are and how they are made. You could draw a picture of a dinosaur fossil or research who first discovered different dinosaur fossils.	<b>Art</b> Design an outfit for someone who lived in the prehistoric era. Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age people dressed differently.	<b>Computing</b> Go on scratch at home. Can you change the sprite and make it move around the screen? <a href="https://scratch.mit.edu/">https://scratch.mit.edu/</a>
