

Here are some ideas of activities you could try at home linked to the work we are doing this half term. Perhaps choose a different activity to have a go at each week. The activities can also be found on Seesaw.

Number Hunt - go on a local walk to spot numbers. Can your child find all the numbers to 20?

Pirates - Help your child to find out more about Pirates from the internet or books from the library. They could have a go at writing one of the interesting facts they have found out.

Support your child to design and make their own pirate flag.

Ask your child to draw a picture of themselves as a pirate. Can they label the clothes they are wearing? E.g. eye patch, bandana.

Make a pirate treasure chest. Your child could use junk modelling materials or a construction kit e.g. lego. Can they make a lid to hide the treasure? Encourage them to put their own special treasures in the treasure chest. What have they chosen and why?

Support your child to write a list of things they would need to take on a pirate adventure.

Go on a nature walk. How many different wild flowers can you spot? Can you name any of them?
