Please try to read to an adult for 15 minutes 5x per week. It's your target!	Use TTRockstars 3 x weekly to practice your tables in 'Sound Check'	Practice telling the time at every opportunity. What time is it now?
Pay for things in shops by adding up totals and working out expected change.	Later in the $\frac{1}{2}$ term, design a poster to show how sound travels through a medium.	Create a document on the computer to show what you know about WW2.
Continue to practice your 6, 7, 8 and 9-times tables so I could ask you anything for instant recall!	Can you Papier Mache a balloon with strips of paper and paste made with one part water and one part flour?	Write a short story, using our expectations, about a character who gets lost somewhere but is finally found.
